This printer is in excellent condition, no cracks, dings, nothing chipped or broken. This printer has performed flawlessly. The printer is compatible with Apple Mac OS 9, Apple Mac OS

X, Microsoft Windows 98, Windows ME, Windows 2000, Windows XP Home Edition, Windows Vista and Windows 7.

The printer comes with the original box, software/drivers CD, roll-paper adapter, matte sheet support, and single sheet guide, owner manuals, USB print cable and three boxes of Epson photo paper is being offered at a great price of \$350. The printer has only been used a dozen times, at the most. The printer was tested a week ago and is working perfectly. During the print test some ink cartridges are running low and will need to be replaced. This Epson is being sold because it is not used very much and it is just taking up space. The R2400 uses nine individually replaceable Epson ink cartridges (uses 8 at a time); prints large format and thick media such as panoramic, portraits, etc; has a roll paper feeder; provides automatic print head cleaning and alignment; utilizes fast connections through Hi-Speed USB 2.0 and FireWire ports. This printer is capable of printing various paper sizes, including 4x6, 5x7, 8x10, 11x14, 12x12, 13x19, 13 inch wide roll paper, and with a variety of paper types. It utilizes Epson Ultrachrome K3 inks. Besides color output, it utilizes advanced B&W photo driver functions which include easy and powerful settings for controlling black and white color tonalities.
